



TLCC WILLOWGLEN 4X4 CHALLENGE 2019

Verification Hints for Team Manager

Verification commences from midday Friday 4 October 2019. It will take place in two stages

1) Confirmation of paperwork

Sighting of the following paperwork will be required **if not provided** prior to verification or if the information has become out of date:

- Evidence of current CTP insurance and registration including proof of payment
- Evidence of third party property or comprehensive insurance including proof of payment
- A current driver's licence for each driver and navigator.
- Proof of CCDA membership.
- Copy of your club's Public Liability insurance.

Each member of the team including the Team Manager will need to sign the TLCC Event Waiver. The team manager will also need to nominate the competing car for Friday night and then be available for the run order draw at 6pm on Friday night.

2) Inspection of the competition vehicle

The Driver and Navigator should review the pre-verification checklist to ensure that the competition vehicle is prepared to pass verification.

The vehicle needs to be presented by both the Driver and navigator – We will be looking for

- ♦ All tyres to be adequately covered by the guards or flares made of a solid construction.
- ♦ Tyre sizes are correct – they will be measured.
- ♦ Seat belts are in good working order.
- ♦ Fire extinguishers are fully charged and adequately fastened.
- ♦ Spare tyre to be carried throughout the event.
- ♦ Safety helmets must meet the Australian Standard and are approved for motor sport.
- ♦ 2 recovery points, **Painted red**, at the front and rear are mandatory. These points are to be painted red and drilled to accept a 3.2 tonne rated shackle as a minimum. **See rule 4.13 for further detail about recovery points.**
- ♦ Snatch straps must be mounted and ready for use, any strap found with frayed sections will be rejected.
- ♦ Fully stocked First Aid Kit must be on board at all times throughout competition.
- ♦ **Window nets** to be fitted to the vehicle as described in the rules.

This list is not complete – just some hints to ensure efficient verification can occur. Refer to CCDA and Willowglen Challenge rules for confirmation of any requirements.
