

History and General Information

The Sydney branch of the Toyota Land Cruiser Club (known as the TLCC) was established in 1969, and has grown to be the largest recreational four wheel drive club in the southern hemisphere. We are a conservative, family-orientated 4WD and social club.

Although originally formed by a small group of Land Cruiser owners, the Club now encourages membership from owners of all makes of 4WDs capable of completing our driver training course.

The Club provides many activities, both driving and social, in a friendly and supportive atmosphere as well as a series of quality Four Wheel Drive Education Programmes to allow members to get the most out of their vehicle in a safe and responsible manner.

The TLCC meets one evening in the first week of each month. Meetings start at 8:00pm and general business is conducted along with trip reports and regular guest speakers. Membership is present at these meetings from 7:00pm to welcome 4WD owners wishing to find out more about us and to join the Club.

The Club has an extensive online presence with a great new look website. TLCC - Sydney along with other TLCC's around Australia has developed an online Forum where members can participate in many different areas of interest including: technical, general events & trips, travel, for sale/wanted and upcoming courses.





Driver Training & Courses

Perhaps the major feature of the TLCC for new members is our comprehensive Education Programme. The nationally accredited Driver Training and Vehicle Recovery course includes a detailed driver education manual and consists of a one evening lecture and a full weekend of practical training. Completion of this course is compulsory before joining in any Club driving activity. Other courses regularly offered by the Club include:

- OziExplorer, Communications, GPS and Navigation.
- First Aid.
- Basic Fire Fighting Training Courses.
- Basic Four Wheel Drive Maintenance and Towing.
- Trip Preparation & Planning, Trip Leaders Course & Basic Camping skills.
- Chainsaw use, safety and maintenance.

These courses and many more, are offered by the Club and are included in your membership fees.

Members can take part in these courses as many times as they wish.

Club Properties

The TLCC owns two separate properties which are fully accessible to members at all times, as part of your membership.



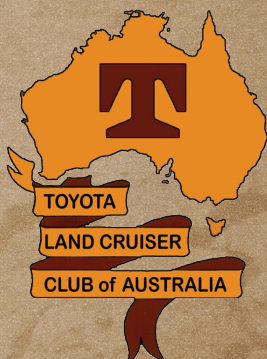
Koolandilly is a beautiful 80ha waterfront block on the Wollondilly River with toilet and shower facilities and a large BBQ/social shed. Enjoy camping, bush walking, fishing, swimming, canoeing etc. in a great bush setting. Many social activities are held on the land along with monthly working bees and some of the Club's training modules which are not driving based.



Willowglen is the Club's dedicated training property situated at Tarago near Goulburn. This 120ha property is used for driving based training modules, camping and special competition events. Willowglen has many 4WD tracks of varying difficulty that members can use to practice their skills. Toilet and shower facilities, power and light in a large purpose built shed are available at all times for members convenience.
